STEP 1: PAY NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP DUES BY CREATING AN ACCOUNT ONLINE

Instructions:

1. Go to www.ncpanet.org
2. Click on **Join/Renew** at the right side of the page
3. Click on **Create an Account** and fill out the required information
4. To **Find My Organization**, search “The Ohio State University”
5. Once you have created your account, check your email for your **username (NCPA ID#)** and **password** and use this to **Login** at the top right hand corner of the webpage.
6. Under “**Join/Renew**”, click on “**Online Application**” and fill out the required information to apply for membership. Membership type is “Student in Pharmacy School”.
7. Complete your **membership payment online** for the number of years of membership you selected, with or without annual professional liability insurance (\$10/year).
