# STEP 1: PAY **NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP DUES** BY CREATING AN ACCOUNT ONLINE

### Instructions:

- 1. Go to www.ncpanet.org
- 2. Click on **Join/Renew** at the right side of the page
- 3. Click on **Create an Account** and fill out the required information
- 4. To **Find My Organization**, search "The Ohio State University"
- Once you have created your account, check your email for your username (NCPA ID#) and password and use this to Login at the top right hand corner of the webpage.
- 6. Under "**Join/Renew**", click on "**Online Application**" and fill out the required information to apply for membership. Membership type is "Student in Pharmacy School".
- 7. Complete your **membership payment online** for the number of years of membership you selected, with or without annual professional liability insurance (\$10/year).
